The title of this seminar is **FOUR EUROPEAN MODELS ON SOCIAL INCLUSION**.

Speakers at the seminar are: Basta, one of Sweden’s biggest social enterprises; Diagrama, the second largest Spanish social organisation, with about 3000 employees; ASPP, a big French social organisation that is now creating a new organisation called Neo-Humanys; and you will also meet Rural Kent, an organisation from Kent trying to create sustainable rural communities through social enterprising.

We might not be best practice, who knows, in your opinion we might not even be good practice, but we are here to discuss our ideas with you so please join in. Come and listen, and share your views on social inclusion.

The seminar is part of a PROGRESS-project called “**Greener Futures for Young People**”. As part of our project we arrange seminars, one in each country, and it has now come to Stockholm’s turn.

Host for the day is **Basta**. Basta is a social enterprise outside Stockholm, in Nykvarn, where 100 people live and work and run a successful business together. Nothing special in that. What is special, however, is that 95 % of the organisation: the board, the management team etc. are former heavy drug users, with an average of 20 years of drug abuse behind them. Since Basta is a social enterprise all profit is reinvested in Basta, which allows for more people to start a new life there.

Our seminar is arranged in collaboration with **Inclusive Europe**, which is a transnational project with the aim of increasing the level of transnational cooperation in the Stockholm region.
